What happens when you get here?

You will find a child-centered environment at the CAC to meet your needs and allow you to tell your story in comfort and safety.



- •The Forensic Interviewer will ask you to tell your story
- •The medical examiner will meet with you to make sure you are healthy and don't need any medical treatment.
- You may also meet people from the police department, DA's office and Children and Youth Services.
- •All these people work together as a team and gather as much information as possible from you to help stop the person who hurt you and prevent them from hurting anyone else.

What is a CAC?

The mission of a CAC is to provide a safe, comfortable environment for children and their families as they go through the interviewing and examination processes after disclosing some type of traumatic experience.



Who is Eligible?

Supports and services at the CAC are free to all children of abuse or victimization.
